

Rich Man's Gold – Cathay Firth by Philippi

Figuring out what might make a future stallion tick often resembles a giant jigsaw puzzle. All the pieces are there. What remains is to simply to fit them together, dear Watson. Where to start?

The best progeny of the stallion's sire (and his immediate family), plus the best runners from the young sire's female line carry all the clues. In the case of Kildonan's sire Rich Man's Gold there's plenty to draw on, notably under his third dam Romanita.

hampion 2yo filly in the US in 1956, Romanita won 11 races during her career, including five notable stakes races. She was a daughter of once-raced Mablen, who in turn was by influential sire Blenheim out of closely inbred mare Golden Manda, 2x3 to Fair Play & a full sister. In Golden Manda's pedigree Fair Play is the sire of her sire Man O'War. Mablen's make-up, in other words, provided a highclass foundation.

Romanita was given every chance at stud. She visited Bold Ruler three times, for two stakes winning fillies. She twice went to Bold Ruler's son Bold Reasoning (whose main claim to fame is as sire of Seattle Slew). getting two stakes placed colts. And with Damascus she got Dimashq, grandam of Rich Man's Gold. The best of Romanita's Bold Rulers was highclass stakes winner Terentia who produced three stakes winners by Round Table, two colts and filly. That filly, Gr2 winning Ponte Vecchio, visited Damascus to produce Edge, the Gr3 winning dam of Gr3 winning sire Boundary.

A son of Danzig, Boundary produced two spectacular colts, Minardi and Big Brown. Their pedigrees make interesting read-

Bought for \$1.6 million as a yearling, European Champion 2yo Minardi is half brother to Tale Of The Cat and to the dam of Johannesburg. His pedigree shows kin-breeding through the female lines of his sire & dam, 3x2 Ponte Vecchio x Narrate (the latter is known locally as the dam of sire Lecture).

Big Brown, winner of two legs of the US Triple Crown in 2008, also shows kin-breeding through his sire & dam's female lines: 2x3 Edge x Syrian Circle.

To summarise, Boundary is kinbred 2x2 Northern Dancer x Terentia (by Bold Ruler, and a daughter of Romanita), Minardi's kin-line is through Terentia's daughter Ponte Vecchio (by Round Table), Big Brown's kin-line is through Ponte Vecchio's daughter Edge (by Damascus). Romanita Rules, it

On to Rich Man's Gold and his progeny.

By Bold Ruler's grandson Honest Pleasure, Rich Man's Gold is out of the mare Dimashq, by Damascus out of Romanita. He started his studcareer in Chile in 1996 before coming to South Africa five years later. That gives an opportunity to evaluate him against two radically

different gene-pools. Or are they? A look at some of the pedigrees.

Pirate's Gold: 4x2 Romanita x Cordoba; 4x3 What a Pleasure x Gav Senorita: 4x5 Romanita x Never Say Die; 3x4x3 Mr Prospector x What a Pleasure x Gay Senorita

Next a look at the kinbreeding in Kildonan's best female line relatives.

Kildonan: 4x4 Romanita x Welsh Pageant, 3x5x4 Honest Pleasure x Tudor Melody x Free For All, 3x5 Dimashq x Never Bend, 4x5 What a Pleasure x Never Bend

Kale: 2x3 Ellida x Pentland Firth; 4x4x5 Martial Loan x Free For All x Pharis (x Joy Ride); 4x3 Vimy x Croix du Risque

Carry On Katie: 5x5x5x5x4x5 Mixed Marriage x Nearctic x Court Martial x Nearctic x Turn To x Free For All (x Pharis x Joy

Sound of Rhum: 3x3 Abadan x Free For All (x Affair x Joy Ride)

In the pedigree build-up of Kildonan's female line, the mare Joy Ride appeared to hold the aces. Her pedigree makes her kin to Pentland Firth' dam Free For All. When the two came together, in Caprica Firth, the number of topclass descendants increased dramatically. We note that Caprica Firth is kinbred 2x3x5 Free For All x Pharis x Joy Ride, 2x3 Free For All x Abernant and 3x5 Donatello x Joy Ride.

Kildonan got the best of all worlds, because his sire Rich Man's Gold's key-ancestor Romanita is kin to Joy Ride, and he also has a kin-link to Free For

Interesting in this context is Elliodor, whose dam is kin to Pentland Firth. From Elliodor and son Model Man, Cathay Firth's daughter Kyle produced SA Derby winner Kale and Majorca/ Paddock Stakes placed Pratique.



PICK OF THE BUNCH

Suitable mares for Kildonan could include:

- Mares with Elliodor, Model Man;
 Saumarez; Second Empire
- Mares with Fairy King or full brother Sadler's Wells (Second Empire, Casey Tibbs, Fort Wood, Ernani)
- 3. Mares with Golden Thatch, Royal Prerogative
- 4. Mares with National Assembly (National Emblem, Announce), Jungle Cove
- Mares with Al Mufti, Captain Al, Complete Warrior
- 6. Mares with Lecture, Windrush
- 7. Mares with Western Winter, Count duBois
- 8. Mares with Cordoba, Northern Guest

(the term 'kinbred' is used to identify close genetic relatives; a benchmark percentage of about 90% is required to qualify; for each dam the kinbreeding percentage is shown as well)

Where From Here

The very best opportunities for Kildonan should be with well performed mares who provide kin-links into his two grandams, Honest Joy and Caprica Firth, keeping in mind the influential grandams of those mares, Romanita and Free For All.

Elliodor and his son Model Man have been successful with Kildonan's female line, as outlined earlier. Elliodor's dam is close kin to Pentland Firth.

Saumarez' dam Fiesta Fun is a key horse in his own pedigree. Fiesta Fun, a daughter of Welsh Pageant, is kin to Caprica Firth.

Welsh Flame, the grandam of Second Empire is by Welsh Pageant out of Crepello mare Electric Flash. Welsh Flame is kin to Caprica Firth. Also noted is that Second Empire is a son of Fairy King, full brother to Sadler's Wells. The brothers are sons of the mare Fairy Bridge, by Bold Reason out of Special. Bold Reason is kin to Dimashq, noted earlier through Rich Man's Gold interaction with Sadler's Wells (Fort Wood, Ernani). Dimashq makes up a trio with Bold Reason and 3-part brother Never Bend, leading to Mill Reef. We note Casey Tibbs, by Sadler's Wells out of a mare by Mill Reef, with his third dam Feemoss kin to Free For All.

A variation on the Fairy King/Sadler's Wells scenario comes through one whose sire and dam are both from the same (Dalmary) female line. That is *Golden Thatch*, whose dam Abella is kin to Free For All, to Welsh Pageant, and also to Pia (grandam of Philippi) and Tularia (dam of Honest Pleasure). A potentially explosive mix, especially if it can be mixed with something that worked well with Golden

Thatch. One such sire is *Royal Prerogative* (damsire of Goldmark), another *National Assembly* (sire of Historic Lady, Bold Thatch).

Royal Prerogative's dam Bride Elect is kin to Free For All, his second dam Netherton Maid links to What A Pleasure.

National Assembly looks most interesting. He's by Danzig (sire of Boundary), his dam Renounce is by Buckpasser out of Bold Princess (Bold Ruler x Grey Flight, and thus a full sister to What A Pleasure). That makes Renounce kin to Rich Man's Gold's dam Honest Joy. Any mare who has National Assembly together with *Jungle Cove* (a successful combo) would get an additional kin-link from Jungle Cove.

Hail to Reason looks important. He's kin to both Romanita and Free For All, and is well represented in the population. Hail to Reason is sire of Bold Reason, of Reason to Earn (mentioned earlier as dam of sire Bold Reasoning). He's also sire of Roberto, which leads to Al Mufti. That link continues to Lecture, in a connection mentioned earlier when discussing Boundary. Al Mufti's son Captain Al looks the part: his damsire Complete Warrior is kin to Honest Joy, while his third dam Beylic is kin to Free For All.

Western Winter is interesting, as he is the sire of stakes filly Carry On Katie, from Kildonan's female line. Carry On Katie is kin-bred through Free For All. With Kildonan and Western Winter there is additional kin-breeding Forty Niner x Gone West, plus Honest Pleasure with the dam of Gone West. Another Gone West-line stallion is Count du Bois. His dam Madame du Bois provides two kin-links to Pentland Firth, through her two grandams Lupe and Milly Moss.

Cordoba was noted earlier, as the damsire of Rich Man's Gold's son Pirate Gold. Cordoba's sire El Gran Senor is kin to What A Pleasure, and is a full brother to Northern Guest who must count for that reason.
